Metroplex Summer Camp RULES & POLICIES

Tuition:

Camp tuition must be paid in full the week before that camps first day (Monday). All unpaid enrollments will be dropped the Thursday before the start of that camp week. If you are dropped you can re-enroll the day of, if camp is not sold out. Enrolling day of walk in does take time so please allow time if you are trying to get to work.

Example:

Thursday May 31st unpaid enrollments will be dropped for Camp 1 June 4-June 8th

Thursday June 7th unpaid will be dropped for Camp 2 June 11th – June 14th

If your enrollment was dropped you can re-enroll the day of camp but you will be required to stand in line. Walk ups are welcome if camp is NOT sold out. This does take time so please allow time if you are trying to get to work. In the event you have paid for a camp that you cannot attend you may request a house credit that can be used for ANY Metroplex program. No refunds will be issued for any reason.

Refunds: There NO refunds, credits or transfers for camps for any reason.

Groups:

Campers are put into equal groups according to age with the youngest kids in group A & oldest in groups F. We are flexible to allow friend or sibling's to be in the same group so long as they are not too far apart in age. If your child wants to be in a group with a friend or sibling please let us know before hand.

Camp Attire- PLEASE COME TO CAMP IN YOUR SWIM SUIT.

Boys swim suit and camp T-shirt / Girls swim suit under shorts and camp T-shirt.

This makes it much easier for the kids to get ready for swim

After swim each child will change in to the dry cloths they bring for the rest of the day (underwear, shorts & camp T-shirt)

Attire: Camp T-shirt: Every camper will be required to wear a camp T-shirt every day of camp. This is for security reason, so we know who is in camp and who is not. If you do not come in a camp shirt you will be required to buy one to attend camp that day. Each camper will receive 1 camp T-shirt per summer; you can purchase additional shirts for \$12 plus tax each. Please label all your child's clothes if swimming.

Snack:

Full day campers need to bring their own snack each day. Half day campers do not have a set snack time

Lunch: Campers should bring a sack lunch & drink each day. Each camper must have their own lunch box. Brother and Sisters may NOT share one lunch box; they may not eat lunch at the same time or in the same room.

Swimmers: Please send your camper in their swim suit. Please label swim camp, towel, and goggles. If you do NOT want your full day camper to swim that's fine, just please let us know.

Drop off procedure: Every c	amper will be given a numbered wristband each day. The
wrist band has a spot on it for the parent to fill out every day .	
Childs Name:	Picked up by:
The parent will then take the tab that t	tears off the wristband. The number on the tab

Pick-up Procedure: When picking up a camper you must have the tab that corresponds with the child's wristband. If you do not have the tab you must have a Government ID that matches the name on the "picked up by" portion of the wristband. Another option is to take a photo of the wristband tab and send to the phone of the person picking the child up.

Late pickup: No charge for the first 5 minutes after pick up time. A fine of \$1 per minute after the first 5 will be charged. Camper will not be able to attend camp again until fine is paid. **Example:** Camp ends at 2:00pm Child is not picked up until 2:23pm an \$18 Fine will be charge.

Campers cell phone, I-pad, I-pod...

We strongly recommend campers NOT bring cell phones, tablet's, I-pods... We allow electronics before camp rotations start (7:30-9:15am) and in the afternoon while in the creative choice rooms.
